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OPENING ACCESS TO NEW MARKETS

- Shareholders, boards, governments and export licensing authorities are understandably reluctant to sell to endusers if there are concerns and/or fears about non-compliance with LOAC and Human Rights.
- Our Law of Armed Conflict and Human Rights training raises the competency and capability of armed forces (including gendarmeries, law enforcement authorities and private military contractors / security companies) by improving compliance with international law and promoting the exercise of restraint in conflict situations.
- Taken together, Pavocat's training and expertise increases (1) the likelihood of shareholders, the Board and government permitting the sale, and (2) the chances of success in applying for Export Licences and End-User Certificates.

ENHANCING AND PROTECTING REPUTATIONS

- By linking mandatory practical Law of Armed Conflict and Human Rights training that is relevant and proportionate to the equipment being provided, a defence contractor enhances its reputation by demonstrating that it is an 'Ethical and Responsible Defence Manufacturer'. The manufacturer also has legal and reputational protection if the purchaser subsequently misuses the equipment.
- Pavocat can deploy active Law of Armed Conflict and Human Rights 'Monitoring and Verification Programs' to ensure the correct use of equipment and thereby protect a company's reputation and allow for a meaningful defence for the company in the event of any Law of Armed Conflict or Human Rights breaches by the end-user when using the manufacturer's equipment.

FACILITATING SALES AND PURCHASES

- Pavocat's expertise in Law of Armed Conflict and Human Rights training ensures (1) that companies can sell to new countries and markets, and (2) that those new markets are now able to purchase the equipment they need.
- By undertaking such training, a State's armed forces demonstrate their suitability for international missions, and private military contractors / private security companies are able to reassure their clients. Pavocat's training and expertise also provides a significant differentiator that helps our clients stand out when bidding for contracts.

PROVIDING OFFSET AND ESG OPTIONS

- Training is provided by the Pavocat-Stellenbosch Academy and all courses are accredited by Stellenbosch University. Training can be provided either at the Academy and/or in the buying State.

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OUR FEES

1. THE RETENTION FEE

- Our annual fee covers the following:

- Assisting you, as required, in securing Export Licences and End-User Certificates.

- Supporting your leadership team in enhancing the company's ESG profile and status.

2. THE SUCCESS FEE

Scale

The Success Fee is ordinarily paid by you:

- On a sliding scale of 3%-5% of contract value (other than in exceptional circumstances); and
- Upon you signing a contract with a new or existing client and receiving payment thereunder.

Payable

Payable in the event that you and Pavocat together secure new business or retain existing business for you.

THE COST TO THE BUYING STATE

COURSE DELIVERY FEE

The fee is specific to the training requirements and logistical specifics associated with each sale. It covers the cost of:

- Training (undertaken anywhere in the world by Pavocat-Stellenbosch Academy); and
- Any other work that is contractually necessary, such as a 'Monitoring & Verification Program'.

COURSE FEE FUNDING OPTIONS

- Paid by the buying State;
- Funded through an offset arrangement;
- Funded by a 3rd party organisation (e.g., the European Peace Facility); or
- Covered in part or wholly by you.
